Outreach to San Felipe, Guatemala

Our medical outreach was full of children this year. Usually our clinics are only about 1/3 kids but this time over half of the patients were children. Most of them had straightforward medical issues and we had the joy of sharing the gospel with them and leading them to the Lord. My own (Amy's) testimony involves coming to the Lord as a very young child so it is definitely on my heart to make sure other children also have that chance. Only kids who are connected with Jesus can overcome the hardships in front of them and impact the next generation with the power of lives surrendered to Jesus.

Our partner in Guatemala, Andrew Loveall with New Hope for Guatemala, works in the schools to bring generational hope and change. We held our outreach this time in Antigua San Felipe school which is the same school where our building team replaced part of the roof in April this year. This school is new ground for the kingdom of God. Our work in the school and partnership with Andrew is opening doors for Andrew to go into the school and talk with the kids. It is legally allowed to speak about Jesus and the Bible in schools so this is a fantastic opportunity. We know that many more hearts will be awakened by the power of the gospel through Andrew's ministry in the months and years to come. This outreach was an excitina step forward.

Just over 1 year ago, Circle of Love helped to plant a church in Mayika. About 40 people were in the church plant and about 20 also participated in the Bible study and discipling class. They came to realize they have a Heavenly Father who loves them and has given them a new identity. They are daughters f God and nothing is impossible for them. !9 ladies have determined to build houses for themselves. They work together to make their own building blocks. When they have 1,000 blocks, they can build one house. Crossroads helps them with cement, windows, a door and roofing. So far, 5 houses have been completed and there are blocks for 3 more. The ladies are full of joy as the work. If you would like to sponsor a house, the materials are \$1,333 or you can do a smaller amount.


